## Basic Eligibility

- ✓ Anderson County residents only
- ✓ Must have lived in Anderson County for at least 1 year
- ✓ Need safe, affordable housing
- ✓ Must be able to repay a 30-year mortgage
- ✓ Must be willing to partner with Habitat through classes and sweat equity
